

Short-Term Study Abroad Program Applicant Guidelines

Prior to submitting your application to participate in a short-term study abroad program, please read the following and initial that you have read, and will adhere and complete the following required items:

Before the Trip:
I understand that each Short-Term Study Abroad Program has physical demands, and I should be prepared physically and mentally, as well as wear appropriate attire. I understand that the program will require strenuous walking, walking on uneven and unpaved grounds, and may involve buildings that are not handicapped accessible.
Academic Credit
I understand that as a Caldwell University student, I am required to receive academic credit in order to participate on this Short-Term Study Abroad Program. I have attained a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA at the time of submitting this application. I do not have any disciplinary violations with the Office of Student Life at the time of submitting this application. I will continue to be a student in good academic and social standing until day of departure for the Short-Term Study Abroad Program. I understand that I am limited to a maximum of 6 credits from Short-Term Study Abroad Program(s). I understand I must receive course pre-approval from my Faculty Advisor to ensure that I will receive course credit towards the applied area, ie. Major, School Core. I understand that I must attend all pre-departure meetings and activities. If I am unable to attend a scheduled meeting or activity, I understand that I must provide legitimate
documentation which will be reviewed by the Program Coordinators.
Application Process
I must complete and submit my Student Application and non-refundable deposit to the Study Abroad Advisor in CARES center/Aquinas hall 104.
I will submit a non-refundable \$300 deposit with my completed application to officially reserve a spot on the trip. I understand that it will be deducted from the total cost of the program. The
only exception that I will be refunded this deposit is if the trip is canceled by the University.

Should I voluntarily or involuntarily withdraw from according to the refund policy as outlined in the "Agreement".
